3. The Course, Clubhouse and Surrounds

3.1. The Clubhouse Kitchen

The kitchen has required urgent repair work due to water damage. This has now been completed.

3.2. Clubhouse Entrance

The concrete entrance slab to the clubrooms is planned for this week starting Tuesday so please be tolerant whilst these works are being carried out.

Luke will create an entrance to the course through the boundary fence near the practice green via the carpark. Entry to the clubrooms will be via the back door via the carpark. Green fees can be recorded and paid as usual via internet banking or cash inserted into the completed cards slot inside the clubrooms.

Please be aware of and respect all safety aspects of what will be a 'construction zone'.

3.3. 9th Fairway Bridge

The new culvert across the stream requires rocks on the sides before it can be used. This will occur when the course dries out sufficiently to allow the rocks to be transported and placed.
